

List of Permitted and Prohibited Items for Green Waste Collection



Permitted Green Waste for Collection

From the kitchen and household

- Vegetable and fruit peelings
- Coffee grounds and tea leaves, including filter paper
- Eggshells
- Manure from herbivorous animals
- Cut flowers and potted plants
- Plant-based food scraps



From the garden

- Grass clippings and meadow cuttings
- Leaves
- Straw
- Shrub and tree trimmings
- Flower cuttings and vegetable stalks
- Weeds
- Fallen and spoiled fruit
- Sawdust, wood shavings from untreated wood
- Feathers, hair



What DOES NOT belong in the green waste collection

- Any leftovers (after meals)
- Meat and fish
- Bones
- Dog and cat feces
- Ashes
- Plastic/Compo-Bag
- Non-biodegradable strings
- Stones
- Glass
- Paper
- Metal
- Textiles
- Treated wood
- Mineral oil
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Street sweeping debris



Biobased and biodegradable plastics, such as



- Compostable bags
- Disposable tableware

Are NOT suitable for composting in our facility.

They require a much longer composting time, and their residues pollute our compost.

The proper disposal method for these items is in the trash bag.

Compostable paper bags are a good alternative. They can be disposed of with green waste.
